WSH, IE, ASP, and ADO. Finally, we top all this off with an explanation of how to use the new Microsoft Script Encoder to 'encode' (which is similar to encrypting) your scripts so they're not so easy to 'borrow.' I did not intend for these comments to run on so long, but this book really is tremendous. The people who wrote and helped shape this book are people who use VBScript in their jobs and in their free time. This is not a regurgitation of the documentation.
